

# 28th Annual NHSCA

# National Wrestling Championships Virginia Beach, Virginia

March 24-26, 2017

The most prestigious National Championships in any high school sport in America. Top 8 place winners in each weight class are officially declared All Americans and will be featured in the National High School Sports Hall of Fame Museum. Approximately 90% of the NCAA Division 1 All Americans competed in the NHSCA National High School Championship events during the course of their high school career. This event also features multiple clinics from top coaches and Olympic hopefuls throughout the event. It also includes a college recruiting fair! More than 200 college coaches and over 1,200 high school coaches from around the nation will be on hand for this event! This event will be webcast LIVE of all 40 mats by Flowrestling for the duration of the event. The 2016 Championships boasted 3,687 registered participants from 47 states and Germany.

## NEW Senior Nationals \*NEW! Open event - must be enrolled in 12th grade\*

Wrestler must be enrolled in 12th grade. Last year 592 wrestlers representing 43 states and Germany competed for the illustrious title! A total of 352 State Champions entered the event including 8 4x State Champions, 24 3x State Champions, 59 2x State Champions and 130 1x State Champions. There were 498 state place finishers as well.

#### Junior Nationals \*Open event - must be enrolled in 11th grade\*

The 2015 Junior Nationals overflowed with talented wrestlers from across the county with a record shattering 976 entries from 46 states and Germany. These juniors collectively won 289 state titles with 24 3x Champions, 48 2x Champions and 121 1x Champions. There were a total of 551 state place finishers.

#### Sophomore Nationals \*Open event - must be enrolled in 10th grade\*

At the 2016 Championships, the Sophomore numbers exceeded years past with 827 entries. Wrestlers hailed from 45 states showcasing 105 State Champions with 27 2x champs and 51 1x champs. There were 363 state place finishers.

### Freshman Nationals \*Open event - must be enrolled in 9th grade\*

Last year was another record breaking year for the Freshman division with 613 entries hailing from 40 states. This includes 176 state place finishers as well as 42 State Champions.

#### Middle School Nationals \*Open event - must be enrolled in 6th, 7th or 8th grade\* March 25-26

This is a premiere event in youth wrestling that is continuing to grown tremendously with another record breaking. The 448 wrestlers hailed from 34 states from Alaska to Florida, California to Virginia and in between. This division will take place during the prestigious High School Nationals.

Registration will open Monday, January 9, 2017. Registraton will close Tuesday, March 21, 2017.
